# What is the LUCKY CHANGEMAKER grant for?

- Socially engaged projects in which art is a catalyst for social change. All disciplines are eligible if they are engaged with physicality, movement and performance (including visual arts, literary arts, dance, theatre, film/video, music, performance-based arts, interdisciplinary/hybrid arts).
- Projects that feature artists
  who engage socially
  underprivileged community
  members who would
  normally not have access to
  culture as equal partners.
- Creative process: We value the process as much as the product. Relationship building is a key goal and projects do not have to automatically result in producing an exhibition or a theatre production. Projects may, but are NOT required to, result in a physical artwork.
- Workshops, training, studio practice, if they directly relate to achieving outcomes of a community-based project.

- Our special grant is open to all applicants, regardless of geographic location.
- LUCKY TRIMMER acknowledge that there is a growing and vibrant community of artists in our own backyard and we have a particular interest in strengthening our local socially engaged artists here in Berlin.
- Individual artists or collectives/ collaborations working locally, nationally or internationally.



#### Realisation of the project

The project must be <u>implemented</u> in the year 2016. The recipient of the LUCKY grant must send us a report once the project is realised with accounts on how the grant has been used or on how it has benefited to the realisation of the project. The recipient of the LUCKY grant will also be invited to present their project at the LUCKY SUMMIT #8 in 2017.
